



His Champion Seasons

Universally regarded as one of the greatest athletes of the 20th century, Muhammad Ali captivated fans with his mesmerizing combination of speed, grace, and power in the ring, and charm and playful boasting outside of it. At the height of his fame, he challenged Americans' racial prejudices, religious biases, and notions about the roles celebrities and athletes play in our society, and inspired people all over the world with his message of pride and self-affirmation.

Acclaimed filmmaker Ken Burns explores the life of the legendary three-time heavyweight boxing champion in ***Muhammad Ali***, a new four-part documentary series.

Drawing from an extraordinary trove of archival footage and photographs, the series details the story of the athlete who called himself "the greatest of all time" and competed in some of the most dramatic, widely viewed sporting events ever, including "The Fight of the Century" (1971) and "The Thrilla in Manila" (1975) against his great rival Joe Frazier, and "The Rumble in the Jungle" (1974), in which he defeated George Foreman to regain the heavyweight title that was stripped from him seven years earlier.

Interviews include Ali's daughters Hana Ali and Rasheda Ali, his second wife Khalilah Ali, his third wife Veronica Porche, his brother and confidant Rahaman Ali, former basketball player Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, historian Gerald Early, sportswriter Howard Bryant, Ali biographer Jonathan Eig, poet Nikki Giovanni, former heavyweight champion Larry Holmes, civil rights activist Jesse Jackson, friend and business manager Gene Kilroy, boxing promoter Don King, New Yorker editor David Remnick, poet and playwright Wole Soyinka, writer Gay Talese, and others.

The series captures Ali's principled resistance to the Vietnam War — which led to his a three-and-a-half-year banishment from boxing — his commitment to his Muslim faith, and his complex relationships with Elijah Muhammad and Malcolm X, who profoundly shaped his life and worldview.

NEVER FORGET: 20 YEARS LATER

WLIW21 commemorates the 20th anniversary of the September 11 terrorist attacks with programs of hope and healing, remembrance and reflection, honoring the heroes, victims, and resilient spirit of New Yorkers.

Frontline: America After 9/11 (9/8 at 9pm) investigates how America's response to 9/11 reshaped our world and our democracy. **9/11's Unsettled Dust** (9/9 at 9pm) examines the massive environmental and public health crisis caused by 9/11 — and the government's failure to respond to it. **Chief: The Heroic Story of Bill Feehan** (9/9 at 7:30pm) tells the story of the beloved FDNY Fire Chief who died at his command station on 9/11 when the south tower of the World Trade Center collapsed. Within days of 9/11, the NYC Department of Design and Construction was tasked with clearing 1.8 million tons of debris from Ground Zero. Twenty years later, employees who still work for this relatively unknown agency tell their story in **NYC DDC 9/11** (9/9 10:30pm).

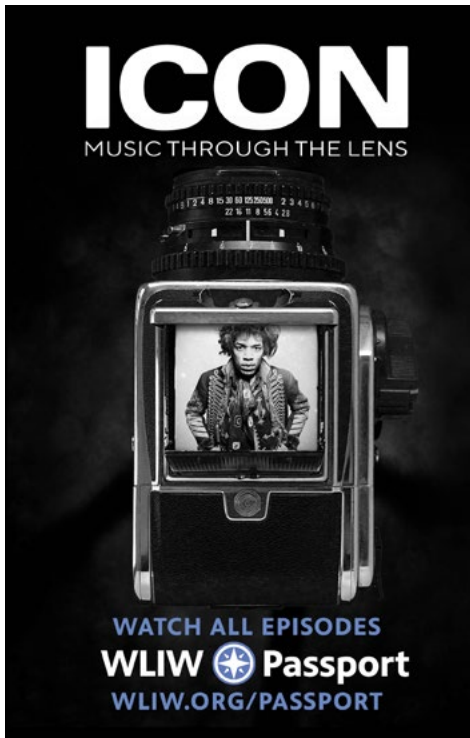

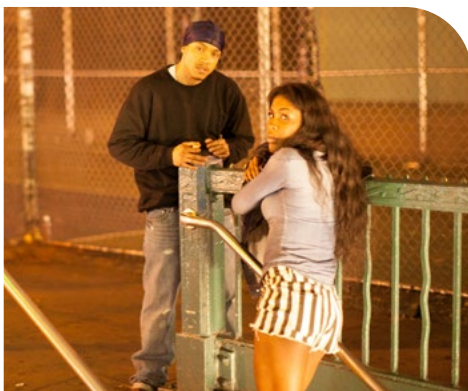
